


Our Mission

- Provide leadership in the planning, development, and oversight of a safe and efficient airport system.




Airports Division – Who We Are and How We Fit Into the FAA?

 - Passenger Facility Charge Program (PFC)




Overview of the Airport Improvement Program (AIP)


- Federal grants to eligible airport sponsors for eligible projects.
- Funded by Airport & Airway Trust Fund, derived from user fees.
- Depends upon continued authorization and annual appropriations.
- Strict rules governing eligibility, procurement, implementation and assurances.
- NPIAS (National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems) airports eligible for funding of airside and other projects depending on type of airport, project and specific AIP category.




- Airfare

- AIP grants




Historical AIP Amounts




Distribution of NPIAS Airports



Number of Existing Airports Nationally (3,340 Total)




Number of Existing Airports Regionally (3,340 Total - 640 in AGL)
