





Roles & Responsibilities

- **OPS Infrastructure Support Center – We mainly support three National Service Programs which are (AJW-242) Unstaffed Infrastructure Sustainment (UIS) Program, (AJW-22) Power Services Group and the 210 Ops Sustain Program.
